

In the wake of the Uvalde, Texas tragedy, we know there are community members searching for ways to show their support for the victims of this and other needless gun violence. Please consider the following options:

- **Everytown for Gun Safety** is the largest gun violence prevention organization in America looking at science-based approaches to end gun violence. Visit [www.everytown.org](http://www.everytown.org) for information.
- **March for Our Lives (MFOL)** started after the Parkland High School shooting in 2018 when Parkland students began an activist organization committed to end school shootings. MFOL is coordinating a march on June 11 with chapters in Columbus. You can't sign up to march in either Columbus, Ohio or Washington, D.C.
